Information Clause according to GDPR

We inform you that:

1. The data controller of the personal data provided in the consent to the processing of personal data above is the Polish Enamelling Industry Association, based in Wrocław, at Legnicka Street 65 B. The purpose of collecting the data is to fulfill the statutory tasks of the Association.
2. In relation to the processing of your personal data by the Association, you have the right to:
 - a) access the content of your data based on Article 15 of the GDPR;
 - b) rectify your data based on Article 16 of the GDPR;
 - c) erase your data based on Article 17 of the GDPR;
 - d) restrict the processing of your data based on Article 18 of the GDPR;
 - e) object to the processing of your data based on Article 21 of the GDPR;
 - f) transfer your data based on Article 20 of the GDPR.
3. Consent to data storage is voluntary, but necessary for the realization of statutory objectives. If consent is not given, membership in the Association cannot be granted.
4. Consent to the storage and publication of photographs is voluntary. If consent is not given, you agree to refrain from participating in photo sessions during meetings organized by the Association.
5. Your personal data may be shared with other recipients or entrusted to other entities and institutions in order to fulfill the statutory objectives of the Association.
6. The data controller will not transfer personal data to third countries or international organizations.
7. The data you provide will not be subject to profiling.
8. You have the right to withdraw your consent to the processing of personal data at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.
9. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, i.e., the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.

Your personal data will be stored for the duration of your membership in the Association, and after membership ends, for the period necessary to settle projects in which you participated as a member of the Association and for the time required to fulfill the Association's archiving obligations in accordance with applicable national regulations.
